

## FEES FOR REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE POLICY

### POLICY

Previous registrants of the NSCMIRTP who require reinstatement of license will be required to pay annual fees on a prorated basis and will be subject to an additional reinstatement fee.

### RATIONALE

Registrants of the NSCMIRTP are required to maintain good standing in the College through renewal of license, and remittance of annual fees. This policy outlines the fees associated with reinstating a lapsed license.

### PROCEDURE

Annual renewal of licensure fees is due on November 1st of each year. Failure of the registrant to remit licensure fees by December 31st each year will result in suspension of the registrant license and an additional \$100 reinstatement fee will be levied at time of registration.

A notice will be sent out to the registrant to inform them that their license to practice has lapsed and no longer legally allowed to practice in Nova Scotia. The notice will include the requirements for reinstatement and provide them with information regarding any required remediation.

Registrants who resigned in good standing and wish to reinstate are not subject to a reinstatement fee. Those that did not resign in good standing and wish to reinstate will be required to remit a prorated annual fee, and an additional \$100 reinstatement fee.

Fees are prorated on monthly basis.
