
Please accept this correspondence in support of \_\_\_\_\_ application for licensing as a Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professional (MIRTP) in the province of Nova Scotia, pursuant to the Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professionals Act, S.N.S. 2013.

MIRTPs are regulated health professionals in Nova Scotia who perform diagnostic and therapeutic procedures on individuals, some of which can be invasive, on individuals. Their scope of practice includes providing health services to seniors, adults, adolescents, and children in health care clinics, healthcare facilities, and correctional facilities. MIRTPs regularly work with vulnerable members of society and are in a significant position of trust with respect to their patients.

MIRTPs are licensed and regulated by the Nova Scotia College of Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professionals (NSCMIRTP). The Board of the NSCMIRTP requires all College applicants, to obtain a current Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check, pursuant to Policy CR-016-01. In order to fulfill our role as a public interest regulator, we are required to satisfy ourselves that our registrants are of good character, are fit to practice the profession, and do not present a known safety risk to the public.
